Presidents Message

As President of the Board of Directors of the HOA of Silver Oaks Phase II, I would like to advise that the Board members have met and the majority vote was to re-open the pool. We have been in contact with the County Health Department and with the HOA attorneys to get the latest guidance on what we should do in light of the Covid-19 situation and in an abundance of caution, we believed it was best to close the pool; however, with additional guidance https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/water.html we received from CDC/Okaloosa County Board of Health, it was determined it is safe to re-open. We want to keep everyone safe and minimize exposure to this virus, and we are acutely aware that with school out, and the children home all day, the pool is a great way to get out of the house and enjoy some fresh air and sunshine. The Covid-19 virus apparently is effectively killed in chlorinated pools. While it is impossible to make sure all surfaces are wiped down, we are asking anyone using the pool to please sanitize any hard surfaces you use, i.e., doorknobs, tables, chairs, etc. and for your safety, please stay at least 6 feet apart. As previously stated, there are NO GUESTS permitted. I will keep you apprised of any changes via Facebook and on the website if there are any changes,

During our HOA meeting on March 17, we discussed the business and additional community projects of the HOA and approved the 2020 Budget. We had a great turnout and wish to thank those that volunteered to accept new positions.

### Tust A Few Reminders...

- Homeowner pole lights must remain lit from sun-down to sun-up for community security.
- During the Covid-19 virus outbreak, the pool will remain open unless or until the State/Federal/County determines it is unsafe at any point. The pool was serviced and pool areas, surfaces, equipment, chairs, etc were all sanitized on Friday and will be weekly. We are asking everyone to stay safe, follow the safe distance guidelines, and sanitize your area with wipes or spray when you leave.
- We also want to remind you that the gates will close promptly at 10 pm. If you are still inside the pool and parking lot after 10 pm you will be effectively locked in.
- Wash, wash, wash your hands.....and self-isolate if you believe you are ill, both for your own safety and for the well-being of your neighbors, many of whom are elderly.
- Please clean up after your pets. This is so important!
- Check in on your neighbors via phone or email just to keep in touch and to make sure no one needs
- Get some fresh air and sunlight and exercise whenever you can. It boosts your immune system!
