## Winter Safety

With the cooler season approaching, it might be a good idea to have your heating system inspected, just to make sure it's working properly so you don't have any unexpected problems or repairs when the weather cools.

While we don't get many super cold nights, there are occasions when the temperatures dip really low so please be sure to bring dogs inside at night and make sure your fireplace is operating as it should. An annual fireplace inspection might be something to add to your annual winterize list.

The days are getting shorter and with the nights being longer, it's a good idea to make sure your lamp post is in proper working order. Lights on for safety! Since there aren't many street lights in our community, having those lamp posts on greatly contributes to a safer environment, as do putting your front porch and exterior garage lights on. Let's work together for a safe neighborhood!

Mattresses, appliances, furniture, electronics require a call to WM for a special pick up.

<u>Hazardous waste</u> like batteries, paint cans, gas cans, fluorescent bulbs also require a special request. Please call Okaloosa County Hazardous Waste @ 850-689-5774 for request.

<u>Tree debris</u> must be less than 6' in length, no more than 4" diameter, less than 50 lbs and must be bundled or put into bio-degradable 33 gal (not plastic) bags. No tree trunks or stumps.



The pool will close for the season Sunday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at 10pm. The pool will reopen in March, usually around the County's Spring break schedule. The exact opening date will be announced on Facebook and on the website at <u>www.SilverOaksFLHOA.com</u>.

#### Pool Keys:

**Phase 2 Homeowners** will retain their existing pool key for use next year. You will NOT have to return the key and be re-assigned another. However, if you lose your key, the cost for replacement is \$40.00, as stated on the pool pass contract. Your pool key will not be reactivated until the HOA dues are paid in full.

Phase 2 Residents (Renters) will need to return their existing pool key and will be re-issued another in the Spring once the homeowner has paid the HOA dues in full.

**Phase 1 Homeowners and Residents** will need to return their existing pool key. They may purchase a new pool key in the Spring for \$175.00.
