<u>Okaloosa County report on progress at Retention Pond #4: -</u> The Okaloosa Country Public Works Department has completed work on renovation of retention pond #4. An issue in the report identified previous actions by homeowner which will be addressed in the President's yearly letter to be delivered with the annual assessments.

<u>W-9 Issues</u>: The accounting firm used by the association is in the process of issuing Form-1099 for vendors and others that have done work over the year. The association is monitoring them to ensure they at correct.

<u>Pool issues:</u> Several issues at the pool need to be addressed prior to the new season opening in two months. Among them are new pool passes, camera issues, tree trimming and stump removal and repairs needed in the pump room. The board voted to allow Phoenix Services to spend up to \$1000.00 to repair the valves on the pump. We are looking forward to another successful pool season for our residents.
